4. Legal Basis and Purpose of Processing Personal Data

The legal basis for processing personal data is the data subject's consent (GDPR Article 6(1)(a)).

The purpose of processing personal data is:

- Maintaining the waiting list
- Informing about the launch of a service or product
- Sending updates related to the waiting list

Data will not be used for other marketing purposes without separate consent.

Data will not be used for automated decision-making or profiling.

5. Data Content of the Register

Only the following data is stored in the register:

- Email address

Data is stored:

- Until the service has been launched and for a reasonable time thereafter, or
- Until the data subject withdraws their consent

The data subject may request deletion of their data at any time.

Possible technical website data (such as IP address and necessary cookies) may be processed to ensure website functionality and security.

6. Regular Sources of Data

The data stored in the register is obtained directly from the data subject via a web form when they join the waiting list.

Data is not collected from other sources.

7. Regular Disclosures and Transfers of Data

Data is not regularly disclosed to third parties.

Data may be processed in third-party services (e.g., email tools) acting as data processors on behalf of the data controller.

Data may be transferred outside the EU or EEA only if appropriate safeguards are in place, such as standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission.

8. Principles of Data Protection

Personal data is handled with care and appropriately protected.

Information systems and service providers are selected to meet security requirements. Access to data is restricted to persons whose job duties require it.

9. Right of Access and Right to Rectification

The data subject has the right to review their personal data and request correction of inaccurate information.

10. Other Rights Related to Personal Data Processing

The data subject has the right to:

- Request deletion of their data
- Withdraw consent at any time
- Restrict or object to data processing where applicable
